Discipline Agreement

Our policy on drugs and alcohol brought on trips is as follows:

If the First Presbyterian Church staff and leadership determine, in their sole discretion, that there is **any evidence** that a student has drugs and/or alcohol in his/her possession, a FPC staff and witness, along with that student, have the right to search through that student's luggage and possessions. By executing this Discipline Agreement, the student and his/her parent(s)/guardian(s) hereby give their consent to FPC staff and leadership to search the student's luggage and possessions.

If drugs and/or alcohol are found in a student's possession, he/she will be sent home immediately. A phone call will be made to the parent(s)/guardian(s), and he/she will be sent home at his/her own expense. The student's payments will not be refunded.

Our policy on discipline:

If a student damages any property or goods that do not belong to them, he/she will be responsible for the cost of the repair. A student is responsible for his/her rented ski equipment and will be required to pay for any damage or lost equipment.

If a student is **consistently disrespectful** to the leadership of the camp or organization, and/or other campers/students, then the FPC staff and leadership of the camp or organization will determine, in their sole discretion, whether the student should be sent home. If it is determined that a student will be sent home, a phone call will be made to the parent(s)/guardian(s) of the student and the student will be sent home at his/her own expense. The student's payments will not be refunded.

Our ultimate desire is for each student to have the "best experience" and the staff and volunteer leaders are committed to provide an atmosphere of excellence for every student.
