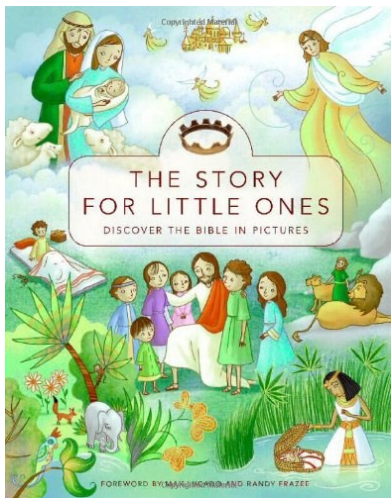

## The Criter Land experience includes:

- Big Idea** – based on the Word of God and spoken in the language of preschoolers.
- Looney Bird & Stretcher** - puppets with a new problem each week - solved by using the Big Idea!.
- The Egg** – an object in the egg laid by Henny Penny each week introduces the Big Idea in a clever way.
- Bible Story** – an exciting story from the Bible each week—the foundation for each week's Big Idea, further infusing the fact that the Bible is the best book in the world!
- Craft & Activity** – to reinforce the Bible's Big Idea, often used to act out the Bible story.
- Ball Game** – using a big bouncy ball, the Big Idea is further strengthened.
- Criter Tale** – the Bible story is re-told by a fictional animal puppet to ensure the Bible story is memorable to a small child.
